How to insert a subcutaneous cannula



Clinical services should only teach carers to insert a subcutaneous cannula in exceptional circumstances and under instruction by a health professional.

1 Wash your hands



2 What you need



6 Prepare the insertion site



5 Take the items to the person



4 Write the date in the medicines diary



3 Prepare the cannula



Peel the back from the cannula packet



Remove the white slide clamp



Rotate the safety shield to make sure the needle moves freely




Remove the plastic vent port



Open the smartvalve connector and screw onto the yellow Y-arm

7 Prepare to insert the cannula



9 Set up the cannula





Hold the 2 bumpy sides of the yellow wings together in one hand

Insert the cannula

Grip the skin with the other hand and push the needle all the way into the skin at a 45 degree angle

Flatten the yellow wings against the person's skin

Stick the dressing over the insertion site and yellow wings
